The PSAM Review is the official publication of the Pennsylvania Society of Addiction Medicine (PSAM) and seeks to connect and give voice to professionals in the addiction treatment field across the Commonwealth.

The PSAM Review currently publishes twice per year, in the fall and the spring. Submissions are accepted on a rolling basis. The Review accepts a wide array of submission types, and some examples include but are not limited to: opinion/editorial, practice update, clinical pearls, commentary, perspective, or message to membership.

Submissions should generally be less than 2000 words. Most submissions should not require any literature citations. The Review does not have a house style which must be abided by.

If you are considering submitting original research such as cross-sectional/cohort studies, narrative reviews, systematic reviews, etc. please, instead, submit a “Research Overview” or “Research Preview” written in a lay, narrative format distinct from your manuscript.

Publications are reviewed by committee, but not peer-reviewed in the traditional sense. Publication is based on a first come, first served basis, as space in each issue is limited by our publisher. PSAM does not retain exclusive rights to content published in the Review.
